Harvest: October, 2007
Hand Picked and sorted

Blend: 100% Pinot Noir

Winemaking: Gentle punch-down during fermentation.
Aged in French Oak barrels

Alcohol: 14.4%

Total Acidity: 0.64 grams/100 ml.

pH: 3.66

Description: Our 2007 Pinot Noir grapes were grown and produced “Organically”. Hand picked at optimum maturity, the wine exhibits rich, ripe cherry/berry fruit flavors with a smooth, silky finish.
